What we do

How does This Company protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does This Company collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Apply for financing
- Apply for a lease
- Provide employment information
- Give us your contact information
- Show your driver's license

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates may include companies with a common corporate identity of **This Company**; financial companies, such as banks and lending institutions; nonfinancial companies such as auto manufacturers, service and product providers; and others such as customer follow-up services, special offer, or notification services.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- ***This Company** does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Our joint marketing partners may include companies such as credit card companies, credit unions, captives or other lenders.*
